January 13, 2010	Respect for Elders' Day	(24) fruit/candy baskets and (12) floral baskets were donated to eleven senior citizens' facilities. Six volunteers assisted with the delivery.
January 14, 2010	Drum Line Extravaganza	(23) boxes of canned goods 1,196 total goods were donated to four food pantries. \$600.00 was collected in cash.
January 11-15, 2010	Elementary School Presentations	(9) presentations were made to Topeka Public elementary schools. A total of 6,985 attended. Nine elementary schools received a total of 2,853 MLK bookmarks.
